Daniel was born and raised in San Diego County, Ca. and pursued studies in biology at the University of California, Berkeley. He had a passion for the environment and what began as a side interest in “stained glass” blossomed into a life-long passion, now some twenty-five years along.

Lead and glass can be used to capture and release or redirect the sun’s rays – there are elements of magic and alchemy in the process. The production of glass itself is thousands of years old and speaks of the ba-

sic elements of the planet; sand, water, air and fire.

Daniel Ford Tarr’s art has progressed over the last 25+ years from perfecting leaded glass and the copper-foil method to now using many additional techniques to create 3 dimensional panels. These include etching, painting, fusing, slumping and incorporation of ‘found’ objects such as sea shells, eye-glass lenses, broken ceramics and antique bottles.

He often portrays nature as seen in his Shorescape Series, and human and spiritual experiences as seen in his Mandala Series of panels.

Daniel is currently working on a Maui Water Trilogy, three panels inspired by the drama of Hawaii’s powerful relationship to water.

Daniel also performs restorations and on-site repairs on

churches, historic buildings and homes.

Daniel ran a successful studio and gallery in Laguna Beach, California and returned to his San Diego County home in the late ‘80’s. During this time he expanded his interest in the environment and worked as a community volunteer and activist through his non-profit organization and elected office.

Daniel has participated in many juried competitions and exhibitions and has received many awards. His

work can also be seen the art glass book: *Creative Designing - Innovative Glass Art*, by Kay Bain Weiner.
